ICT in the Community

Children across the school really enjoyed their second session with ICT Coaches on Tuesday. The first part of each session is classroom based with a literacy focus then the children go outside for skills-based activities for the remaining time. These sessions are being paid for using money from the Strathnairn Community Benefit Fund and Stratherrick & Fovers Community Trust money. Children should come to school wearing PE kit and have appropriate outdoor shoes to wear for this activity. Please note wellies or Crocs should not be worn for physical activity.
